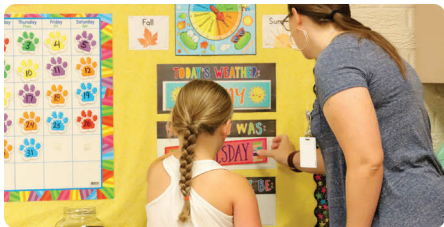
2023-2024 AT A GLANCE

School Improvement Goal #1: 80% of our K-5 Students will be proficient on the DIBELS assessment by the end of the year. 80% of our students will be proficient on NSCAS at the end of the year.

- The Building Leadership Team uses a process to ensure that the school allocates and adequately protects time for core instruction in ELA. (Met)
- The school team uses a process to ensure that effective universal practices are implemented with fidelity (Academic Vocabulary/Academic Language).
- Grade level PLCs are established to support the implementation of Universal Instruction (i.e. PLC progressions and routines) - This strategy replaced the first strategy when we met it in December.

School Improvement Goal #2: We will create a safe and predictable learning environment by implementing a School-wide value system, scoring 80% or higher on the Tiered Fidelity Inventory in all three subscales (Teams, Implementation, and Evaluation).

- Tier 1 features (school-wide expectations, routines, acknowledgements, in-class continuum of consequences) are implemented within classrooms and consistent with school-wide systems.
